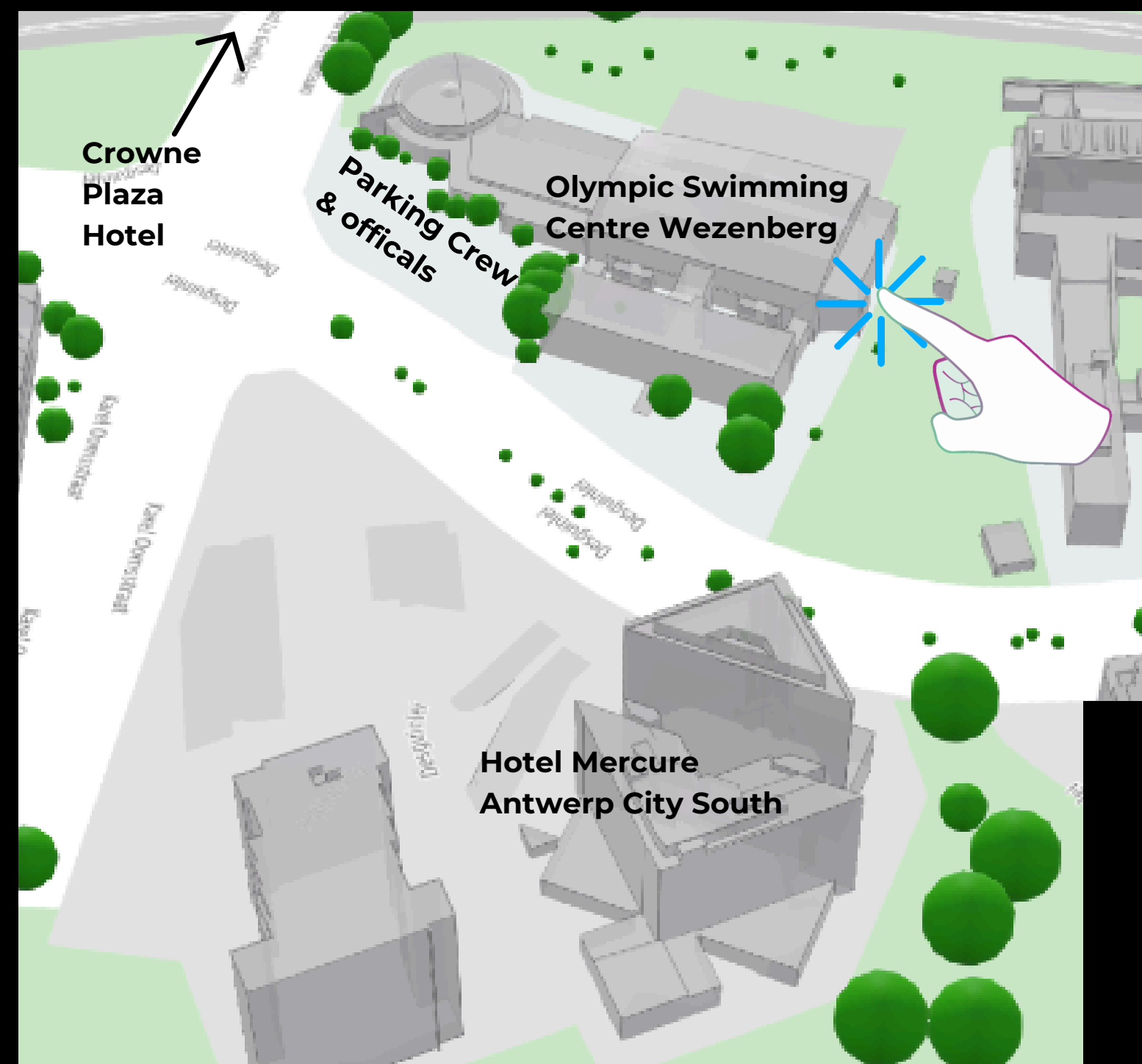
When facing the building, the team entrance is at the right side.

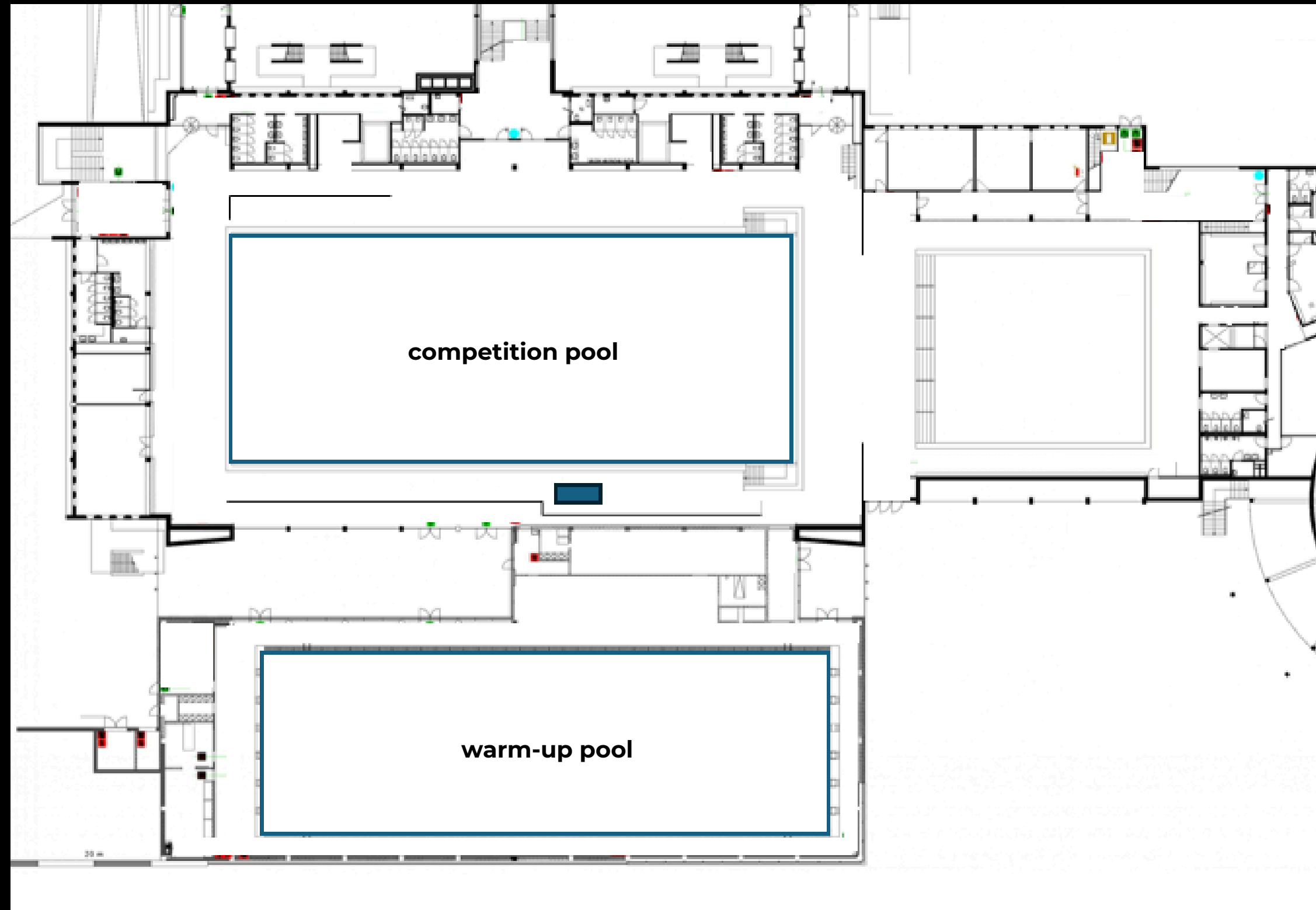

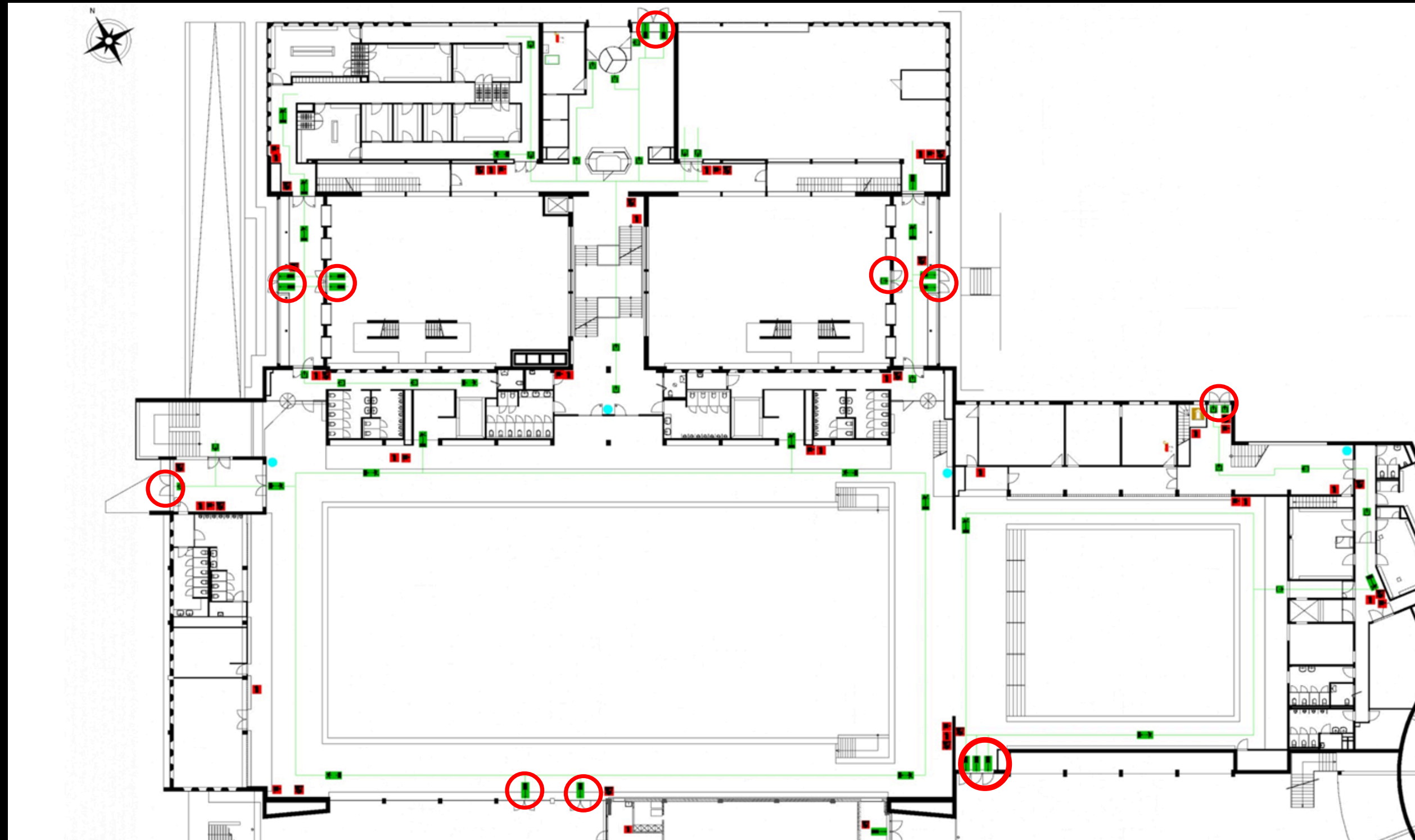

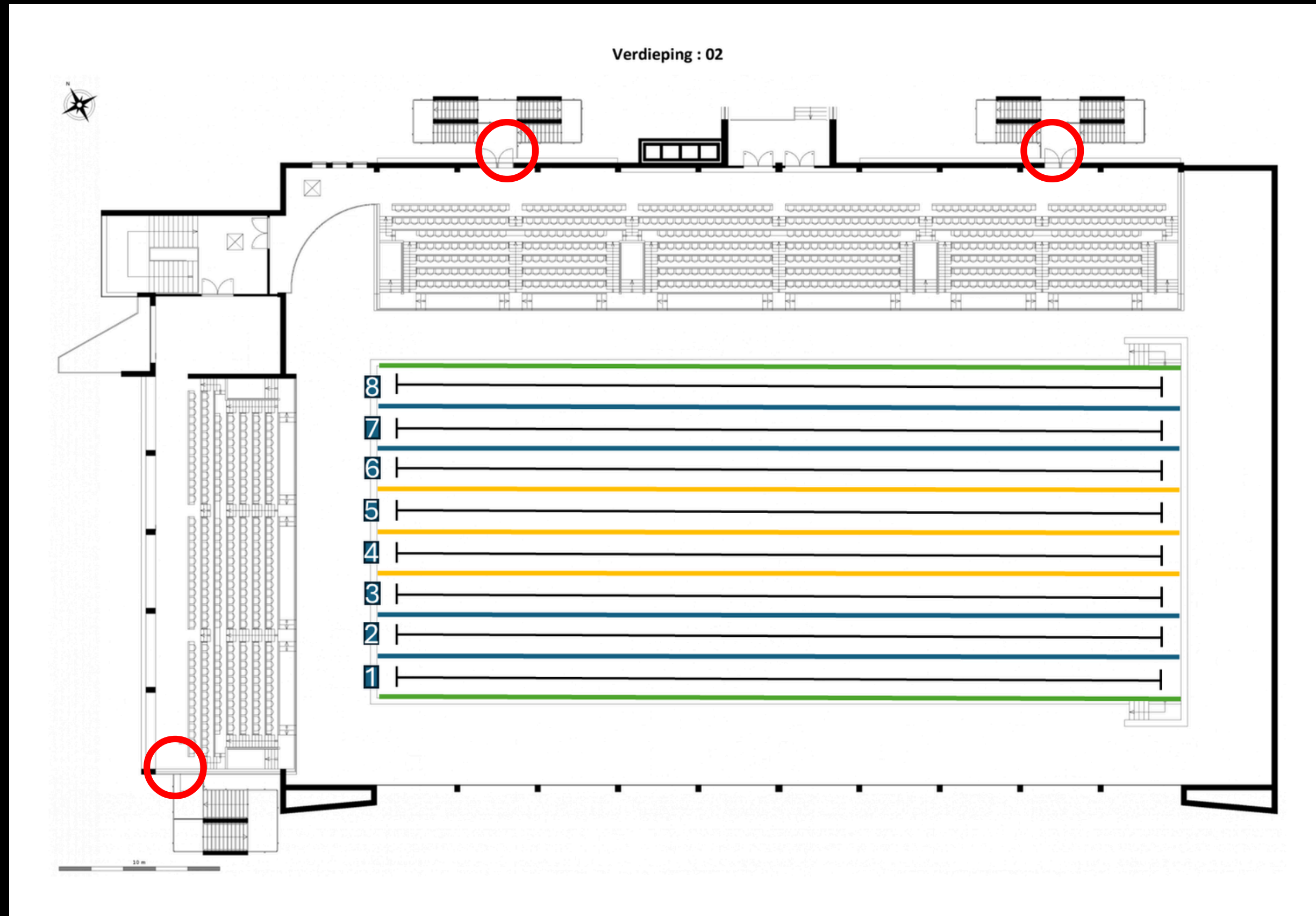

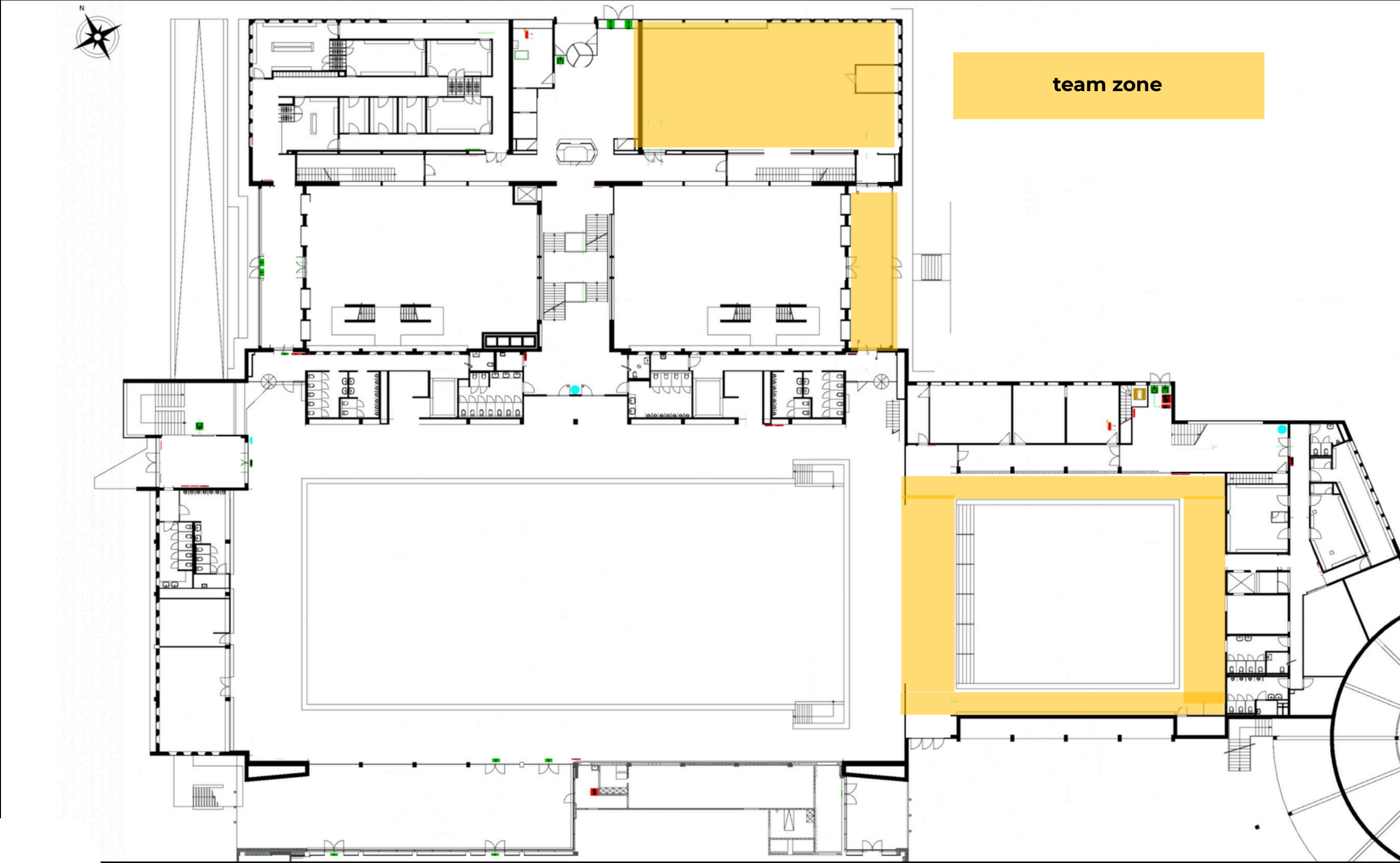

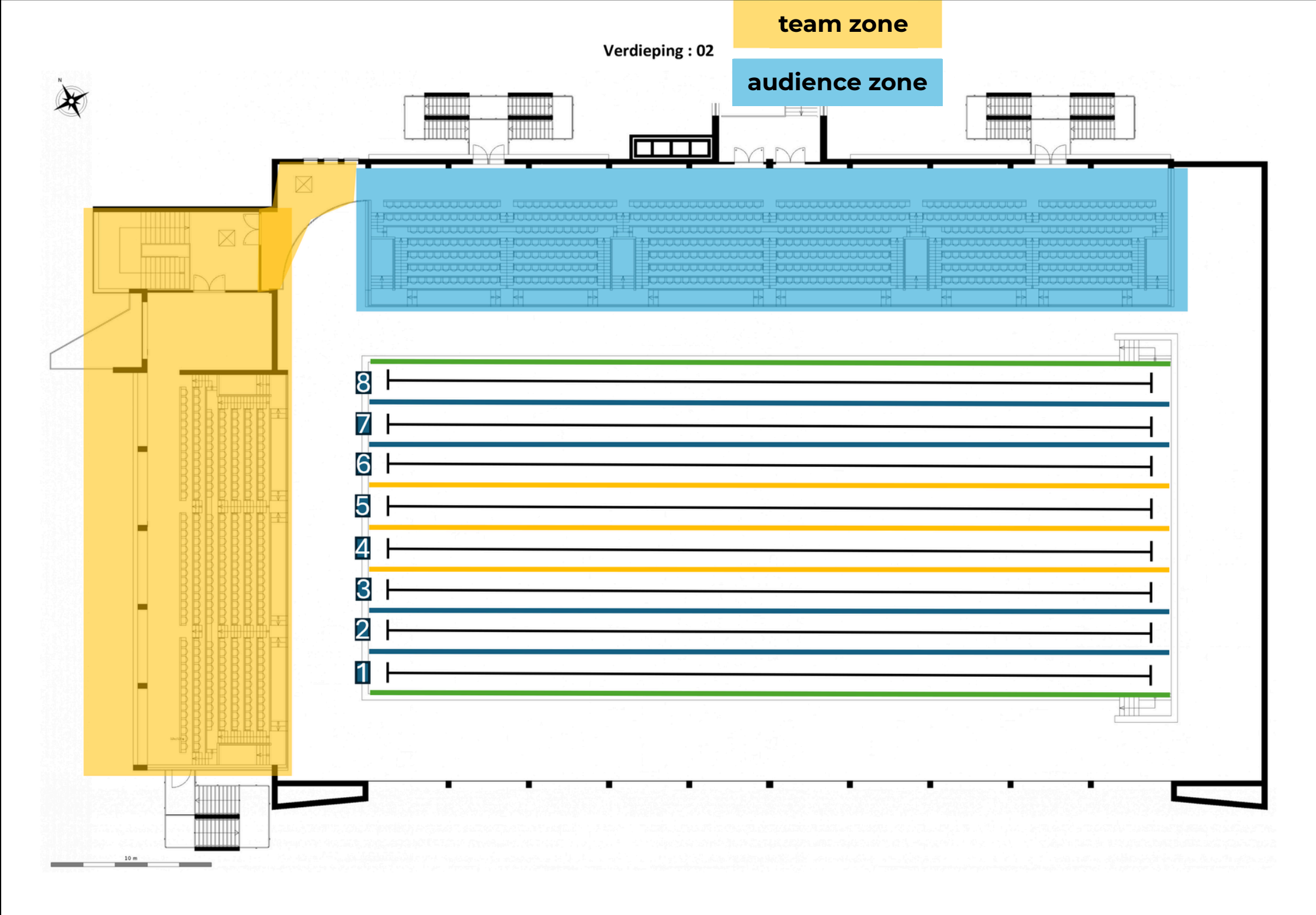

- Please ensure that the floor is clear and clean when you leave the building!



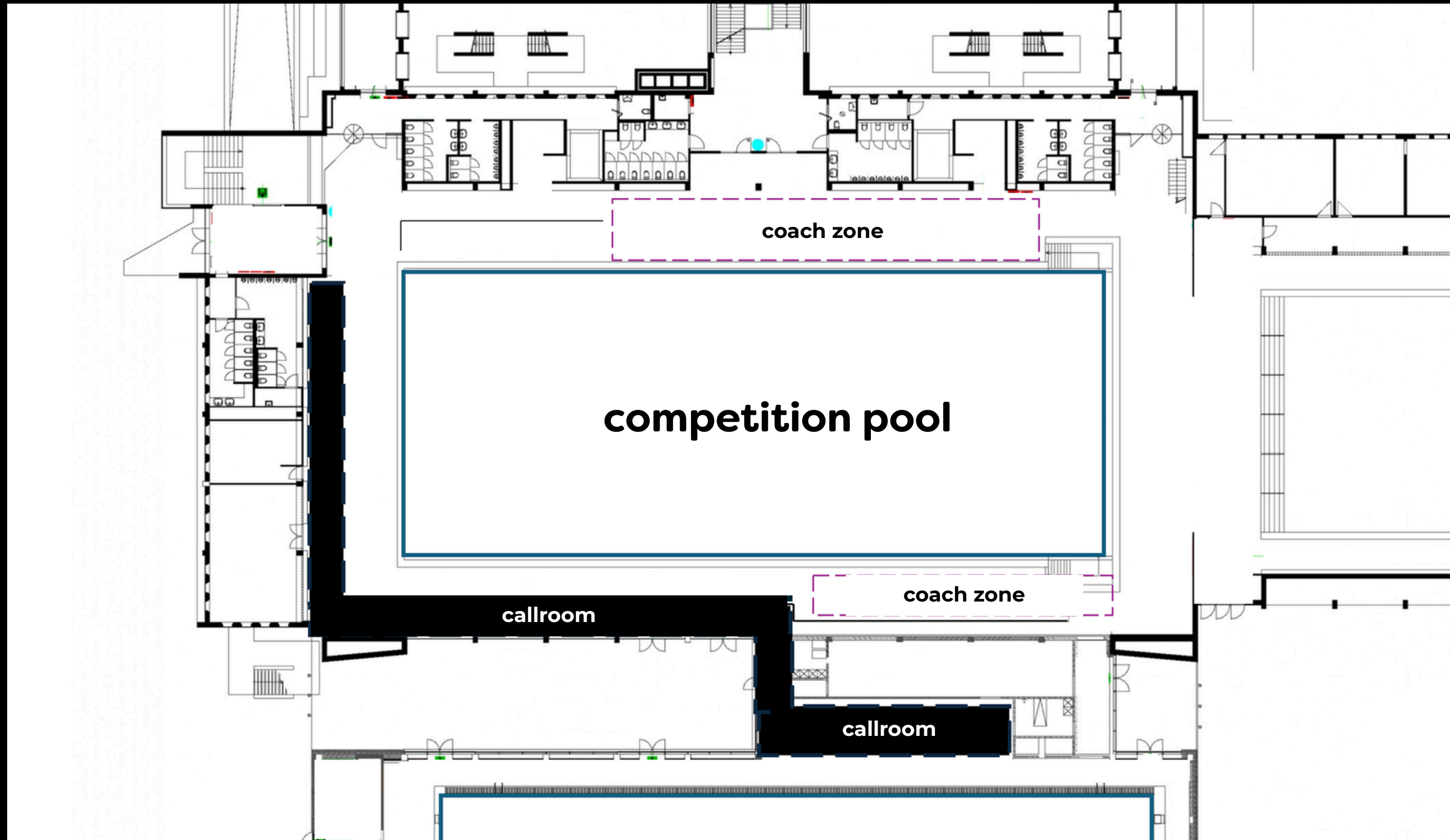
Coachzone

Field of play: Callroom

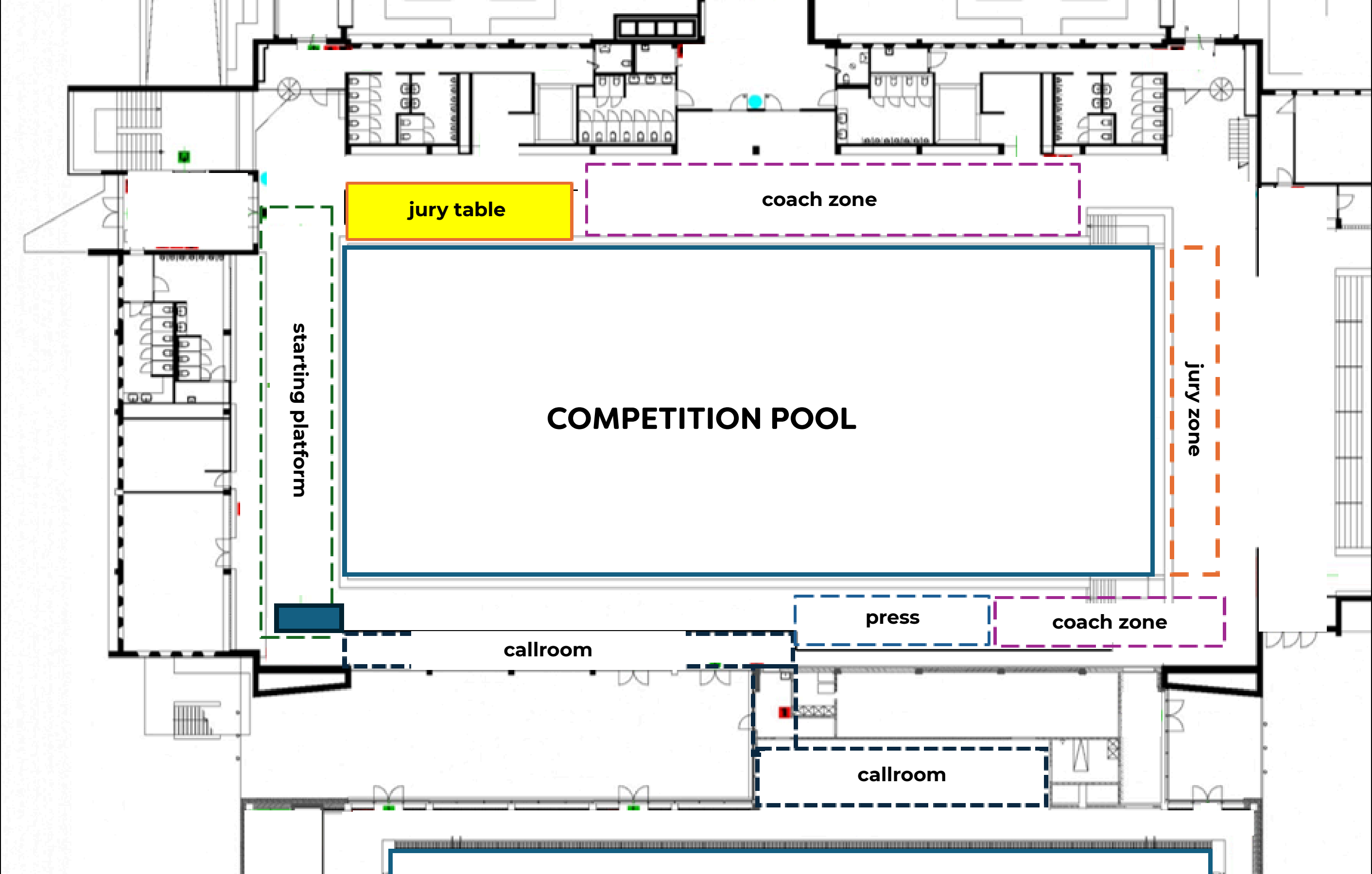


Field of play: Callroom

- There are **4 call rooms**, These are not accessible to coaches and delegates (Exception: guides of para swimmers with **an 'A', 'T' or 'Y' exception code**);
- Passing by the call room is prohibited for those who have not been called;
- Please note: the times in the program are indicative;

 - Protest/appeal;

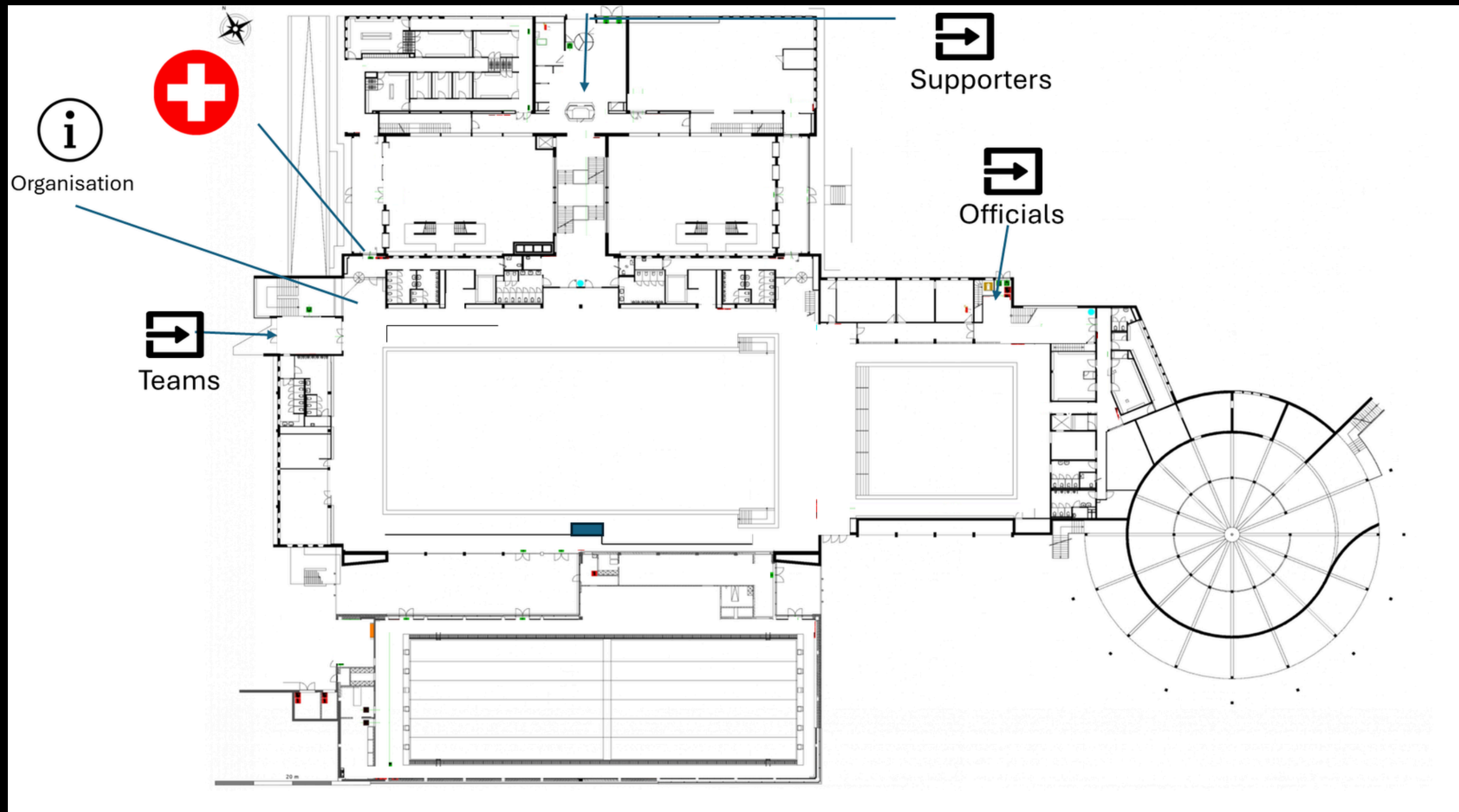

7:30 - 8:45 AM - Warm-up @ competition pool & Warm-up pool

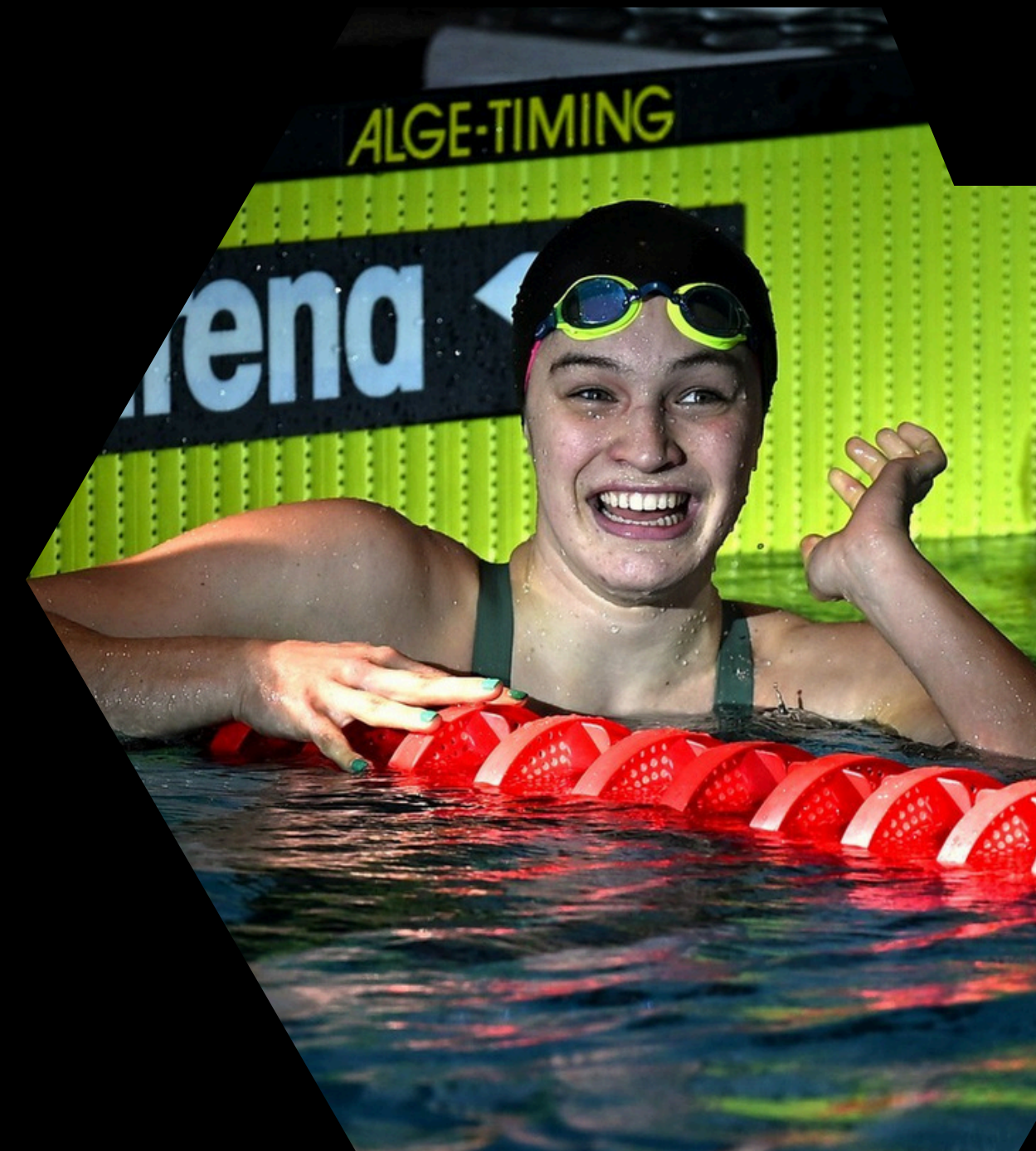
9:00 AM - start competition;

The warm-up pool is available until **30 minutes** after the end of the competition.

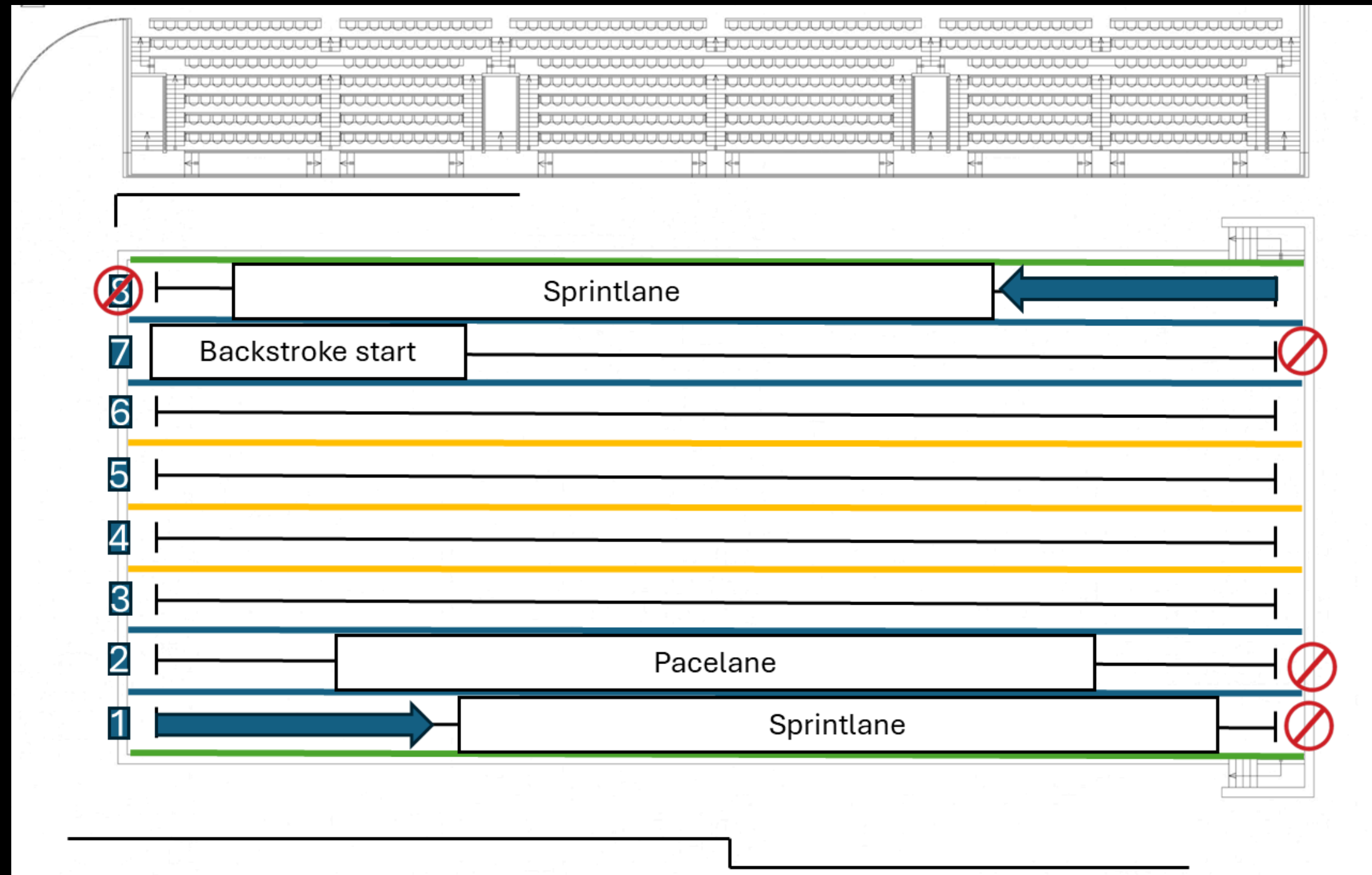


Warming-up (starting situation)

(30 min. before the end of the warm-up)



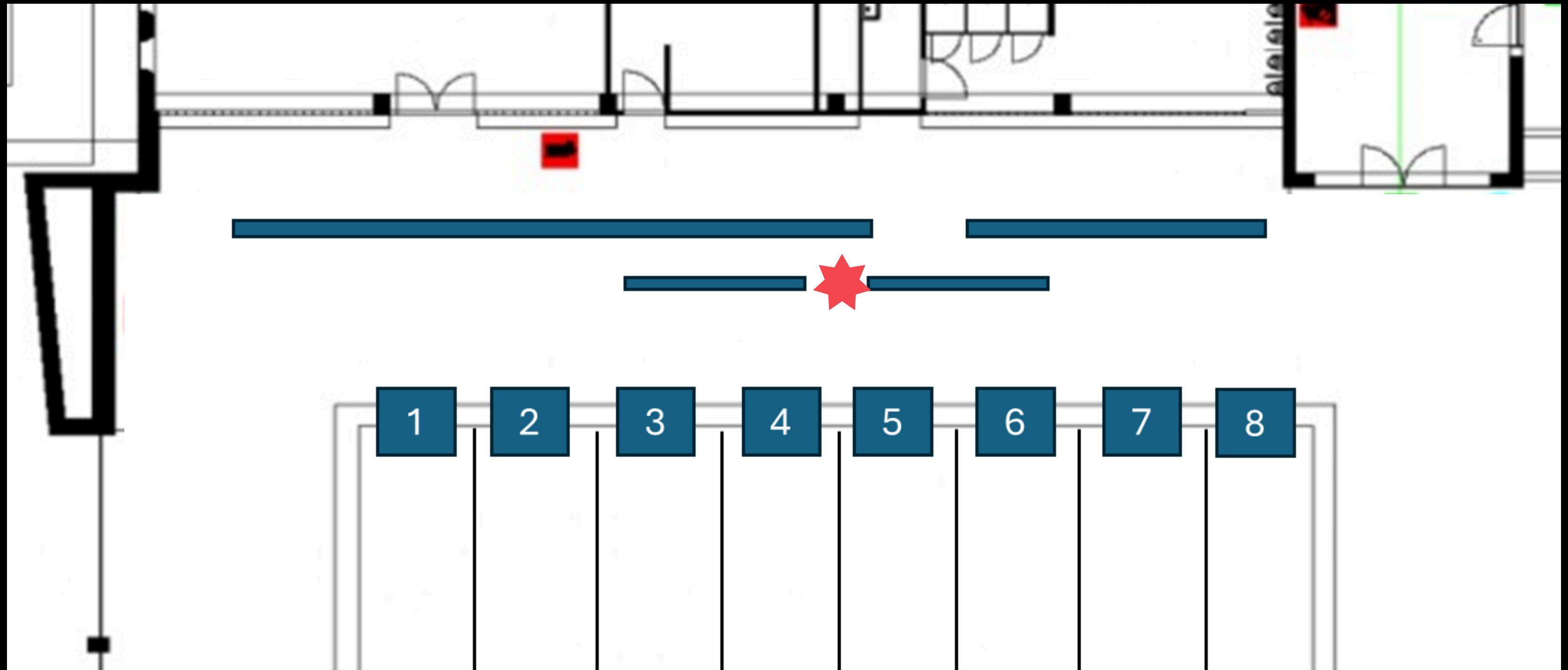
Finals

- Final:
 - an open A final;
 - B Final: only for swimmers holding a valid licence of a Belgian team or swimmers with the Belgian nationality, who are not qualified for the A final.
- For each event, we will start with the A final, followed by the B final.
- We will organise a podium ceremony after every B-final.
- Withdrawals for the finals must be reported at the Resolution Desk by completing a withdrawal form within **30 minutes** after the official announcements by the speaker
- If a swimmer is listed as a reserve, a withdrawal form must still be submitted if the swimmer will not participate in the final.

Finals: presentation of the swimmers

- Swimmers will be presented to the public as they enter the starting deck for both the A and B finals.
- The camera will capture each swimmer from the moment they stand on the mark between the two “walls.”
- The presentation order is as follows: 8 – 1 – 7 – 2 – 6 – 3 – 5 – 4.
- After their race, swimmers must leave the starting pontoon via the side exit.

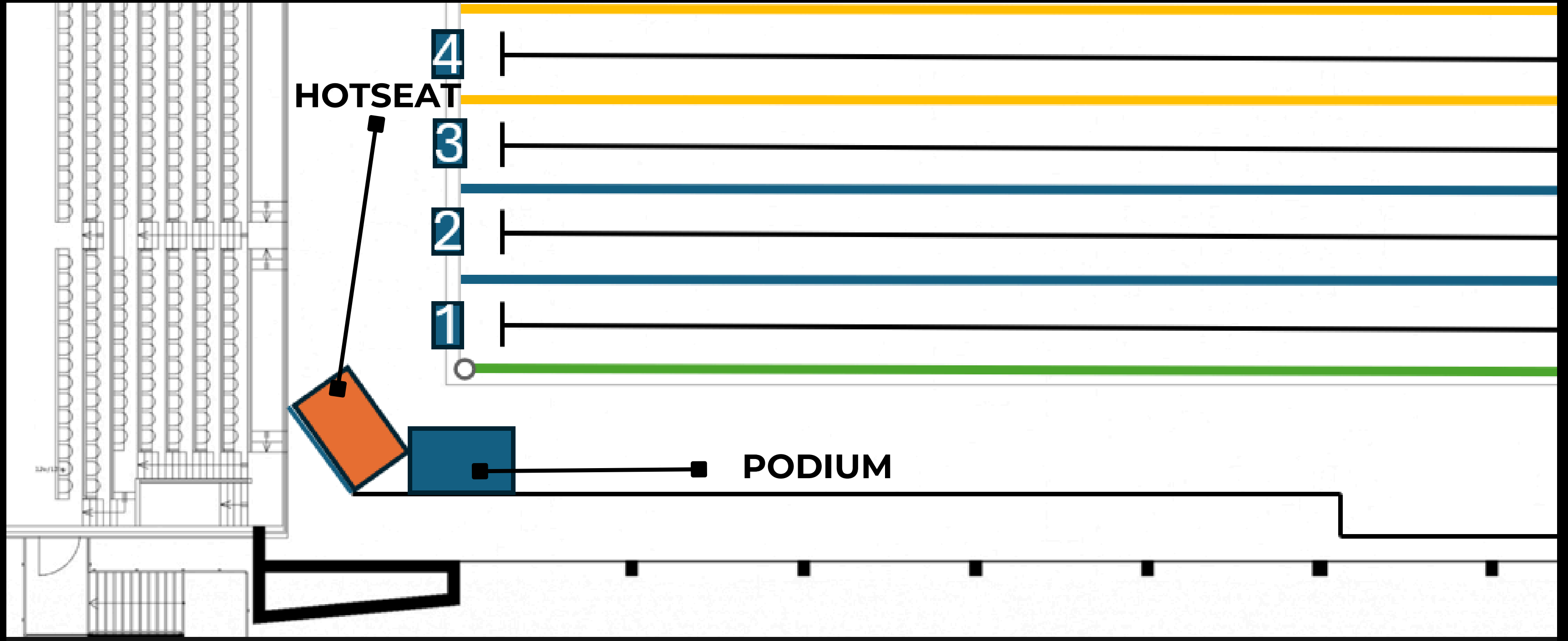
Finals: presentation of the swimmers



Podium Ceremony

- The first three Belgian athletes in each individual event receive a medal.
- Athletes with a foreign nationality receive a medal only if they finish in the top three of the individual event.
- For each relay event, the RBSF provides the required medals.
- Medals for relay events are awarded only to Belgian teams (podium limited to the first three relay teams from Belgian teams).
- The title of “Belgian Champion” is awarded to the first Belgian swimmer or Belgian team in the final.
- If no Belgian swimmers qualify for the A final, the results of the B final determine the Belgian ranking. In that case, the highest placed Belgian swimmers from the B final are considered.
- The top three finishers of the A final remain in the “hot seats” for the medal ceremony.

Podium Ceremony



Important Moments

- When a Belgian swimmer qualifies for a **European Championship at senior level**, they will be invited onto the podium to receive a symbolic plane ticket to Paris, after pressing the big red button.
- For the 50m races the big red button will be placed at the turnside of the pool
- When a Belgian swimmers breaks a **national record at senior level**, they will be invited onto the podium to take a picture with the Belgian record poster.

Key points of the jury

The Open Belgian Championships Long Course 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the official World Aquatics Swimming Rules (in force as from February 2026).

2.8.6 AND 2.8.7 (2.8 Inspector of Turns)

2.8.6 In **individual Freestyle races of 400m, 800m and 1500m**, each Inspector of Turns at the starting end and turning end of the pool will record the number of laps completed by the Athlete in the lane monitored. **The Athletes will be informed of the remaining number of laps to be completed by the display of “lap cards” that show odd numbers at the turning end of the pool.** The “lap cards” must be displayed either at deck level or in the water (at the LOC’s discretion based on availability at the venue). Electronic equipment for the same purpose, including underwater display, may be used.

2.8.7 Each **Inspector of Turns at the starting end** will give a **warning signal** when the Athlete in their lane has two laps plus five (5) metres to swim to finish in **individual Freestyle** races of **400m, 800m and 1500m**. The signal must be repeated after the turn until the Athlete has reached the 5 meter-mark on the lane rope. The warning signal may be by whistle or bell.

Key points of the jury

2.17.1

(2.17 Resolution Desk Judges)

Resolution Desk Judges will be available to receive initial queries from team leaders, such as inquiries regarding withdrawals, disqualifications, and swim-offs. The Resolution Desk Judges will communicate queries to the Technical Swimming Committee.

5.4

(5 Freestyle)

Once some part of the head of the Athlete has passed the 5 meter-mark, immediately prior to reaching for the finish wall, the Athlete may be completely submerged.

Key points of the jury

2.18.1

(2.18 Warm-up Supervisor)

Warm-Up Supervisors shall oversee warm-up sessions in the Competition Pool, ensuring that Warm-Up Guidelines are adhered to and the lanes used as defined.

Competition pool

- There is NO DIVING OR BACKSTROKE STARTS AT ALL until 45 min. prior to the end of warm up, and then diving or backstroke starts only in those lanes marked to do so.
- There is NO DIVING IN CIRCLE SWIMMING LANES, entry to these lanes is to be feet first. Circle swimming is anti-clockwise.
- **No other equipment than a kickboard or pull buoy is allowed in the Competition Pool (e.g. no paddles, no fins, no rubber bands, no parachutes, etc.)**

KEY POINTS OF THE JURY

7.2 AND 7.3

(7 Breaststroke)

7.2 From the beginning of the first arm stroke after the start and after each turn, the Athlete's body must be on the breast.

7.3 It is not permitted to roll onto the back at any time, except at the turn after the touch of the wall when it is permissible to turn in any manner as long as the body is on the breast from the beginning of the first arm stroke after leaving the wall. From the start and throughout the race the stroke cycle must be one arm stroke and one leg kick in that order. All movements of the arms must be simultaneous without alternating movement.

Key points of the jury

8.2 AND 8.6 (8 Butterfly)

8.2 It is not permitted to roll onto the back at any time, except at the turn after the touch of the wall when it is permissible to turn in any manner as long as the body is on the breast from the beginning of the first arm stroke after leaving the wall.

8.6 (...) It is permissible for the Athlete to be completely submerged once his/her head has passed the 5 meter mark prior to reaching the end.

Key points of the jury - Miscellaneous

- Team leaders meeting

A short team leaders meeting will be organized every competition day, 30 minutes before the start of the first heat, at the entrance of the call room. Attendance is mandatory.

- Disqualifications

If there is a **DISQUALIFICATION (DQ)**, 'DQ' will be shown on the final result list. The team leader will have to report to the Resolution Desk in order to learn more about the DQ details.

- Withdrawals for the finals

If you want to **withdraw an athlete from finals**, be precise and mention clearly on the withdrawal form whether you withdraw from A **or** B finals or in due case, for both. Reserves for A and B finals that don't swim their finals also have to withdraw in writing.

- Tapes are allowed

According to statement at the EA Swimming Clinic, Sofia, BUL, 28 February - 01 March 2026, **taping is allowed**. However, please note that fingers and toes may only be taped in pairs.

- Open training on Thursday starting 7:00 PM until 8:30 PM in the competition pool.

TICKETS FOR COACHES

- Every coach, teamleader, and staff member must have a ticket to enter the swimming pool. At the entrance, the ticket will be scanned and exchanged for a bracelet.
